It's okay to not be okay

Therapy serves as a vital resource in nurturing mental health and overall wellbeing, offering individuals a safe and supportive space to explore their thoughts, emotions, and experiences. While it is a necessity for most individuals, it's also considered to be a taboo in our country. Any institution or organisation that offers therapy as a service can benefit greatly from it, but few have been able to integrate the therapeutic process into their operations because of this stigma. NSBT has become the first institute in CSN to have this provision for their students' overall growth and development. Whether facing stress, anxiety, depression, trauma, or relationship issues, therapy offers tools and techniques to manage emotions, improve communication, and cultivate resilience.

Furthermore, therapy fosters a sense of validation and acceptance, allowing individuals to express themselves openly and without judgment. Individuals are encouraged to explore their feelings and experiences in a safe and confidential environment, free from societal pressures or expectations. This sense of validation can be profoundly healing, helping individuals to develop self-awareness, self-compassion, and a greater sense of self-worth. Therapy serves as a catalyst for positive change, empowering individuals to overcome obstacles, pursue their goals, and live more authentically.

I have found working with students to be really fulfilling and invigorating. The aforementioned stigma associated with therapy makes it extremely difficult for students at first to open up and discuss the challenges they face. However, once they are able to let go of their fear and attend the first session, they are able to make significant progress and come to view therapy as a place of refuge.

My experience here at NSBT has been very similar and understandably so. The students were initially not so keen on letting others know that they are going for therapy. However, once they saw their peers also go for it, it made them a little more open to the idea of seeking help for their mental health. They are now able to navigate their concerns with the interventions and various techniques that are suggested to them. The majority of them have made excellent progress in the past month and are eager to keep improving on their own. As a therapist, it fills me with great pride to witness their resilience and independence in handling their own difficulties with the assistance of constructive coping mechanisms.

In conclusion, my experience as a therapist in this institute has been nothing short of transformative. It has deepened my understanding of mental health, broadened my skills, and reinforced my passion for helping others.

CSN FACTS N FIGURES The Silk Route's Legacy and CSN's Historical Weave

The Silk Route, operational from the Second Century BCE to the Eighteenth Century CE, served as a vital network for cultural, commercial, and technological exchanges from China to the Mediterranean. This extensive network helped integrate diverse cultures through trade in silk, spices, textiles, and gems. Within this network, Aurangabad, Maharashtra, emerged as a key player due to its exquisite Paithani silk sarees, showcasing the city's significant role in the global textile trade.

Paithani weaving, originating around 200 BCE in Paithan, flourished under various dynasties, notably during the Mughal era under Emperor Aurangzeb in the Seventeenth Century. These sarees, known for their vibrant colors and intricate gold and silver thread work, not only illustrate the cultural fusion along the Silk Route but also highlight advancements in textile manufacturing.

Today, the tradition of Paithani sarees continues to thrive, symbolizing Aurangabad's rich historical heritage and its ongoing cultural contributions.
